SMART LMI wants to develop and test an app which bridges the gap between open European labour market information data and skills assessment. It will address growing skills mismatches in Europe. The Commission has developed ESCO, a multilingual classification of skills, competences, qualifications and occupations, to facilitate the development of services that match people to jobs or guide them towards employment opportunities that best match their skills. ESCO can also play a key role in better understanding and assessing big data on labour market needs, thus improving traditional skills intelligence and skills forecast - the aim is to inform policy makers, education providers and jobseekers on new jobs and on the skills needed in the future. In this overall context and more than one year after its launch, ESCO has already been used in a substantial number of IT implementations. Dimitrios will show some best practices.
